Swinton Football Club is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for children and young people to practice Youth Football. This policy applies to all players irrespective of their age, culture, ability, gender, sexual identity, language, racial origin or religious belief.

Players Respect Code

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

As a player, you have a big part to play.

That's why Swinton FC and The FA are asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

- **When playing football, I will:**
 - Always play to the best of my ability
 - Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
 - Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager
 - Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
 - Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
 - Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me
 - Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.
- **I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:**
- **I may:**
 - Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
 - Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
 - Be dropped or substituted
 - Be suspended from training
 - Be required to leave the club.
- **In addition:**
 - My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
 - The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.
