- Are trained to the appropriate level and qualified in respect of
 - Coaches to FA Level 1 Standard, Child protection & Emergency First Aid
 - Trainers and volunteers to child protection and Emergency first aid.
- Agree and commit to abiding by all the clubs rules, codes of conduct, to attending all relevant meetings and attend any re-training or refresher training deemed appropriate by the club.
